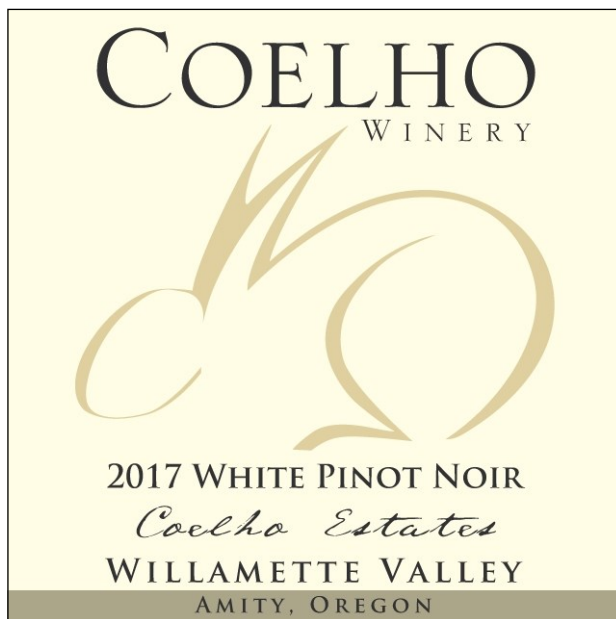

Varietals: Pinot Noir

Vineyards: 80% Delfina Vineyard (McMinnville AVA) and 20% Coelho Vineyard (Van Duzer Corridor AVA)

Brix at Harvest: 22.5°

Harvest Date: October 2017

Vinification Techniques: Hand-picked and whole cluster-pressed using a Champagne-style press program. The juice was settled and racked to neutral 228-liter French oak barrels where it stayed with no intervention other than topping for 18 months before being blended and mellowing in tank for two additional months. It went through partial malolactic fermentation.

Cooperage: 100% neutral French oak for 18 months

Bottling Date: September 2018

Production: 75 cases
